Many of us hold closely the idea that our homes ARE places of worship! Now, in the midst of a trying season we find ourselves living out that truth in a more intentional way than ever before.

I hope you have been able to find peace in this time that is characterized by uncertainty and anxiety. I hope that you have been able to make your home a place of worship where the saints, your family members, gather to worship, pray, fellowship and study God's Word.

It is with this in mind that I offer this simple tool, the *Living Room Liturgy*, that I hope you will find helpful. Keep in mind that this is not meant to be followed strictly but adapted and molded to fit your specific family needs. It is meant to help you be intentional in your home worship.

First, determine in your heart with much prayer to establish a set time to worship with your family.

Second, eliminate distractions. There are many things competing for your time and interest, even tacitly. The time we spend worshipping as a family matters. How we do it matters, not in the sense of traditions but in spirit and in truth.

Since we are meeting in homes, you will find that what is traditionally handled by many loving saints is now in your hands. You are the greeter, coffee-maker, deacon, children's ministry director, worship leader, youth leader, pastor, cleaning crew. What a blessing to be able to serve our families in this way! This may take a few extra minutes but is well worth it.
